WELCOME

Dear Parent,

Thank you for your interest in our School Transport services. This guide for the 2026 / 2027 academic year provides information on the wide range of travel options available to pupils at Bromley High School and I hope you will find it of use.

The Bromley High School bus service continues to be managed on our behalf by Vectare, a specialist school transport management company. All bookings for our school coach routes must be made via our online booking system, which can be accessed at bromleyhigh.vectare.co.uk. You can book travel 24/7 and, subject to availability, bookings are accepted right up until the service is due to depart.

Payments are made online via direct debit. Payment can still be made on a termly basis for regular travel, and ad-hoc travel is paid for at the time of booking.

All our minibuses are maintained to a high standard and equipped with seatbelts at every seat. We use friendly, DBS checked drivers who have all

undertaken the MiDAS minibus or professional driving qualifications.

I hope that you are able to find a travel solution that works for you and your daughter. If you need any further assistance, or you would like to discuss travel options from areas not currently served by our school bus network, please contact us via the school transport website and we will be pleased to assist.

FIVE STAR SERVICE



All of our vehicles are modern, easy-to-board and are operated by the school. This means that they are all regularly maintained to the highest standard, giving you peace of mind that your daughter is travelling in safety.



We use dedicated drivers who work on the same route each day. These drivers get to know the pupils and are subject to an enhanced disclosure and barring service (DBS) check.



We offer a wide range of different tickets on our school bus service. From a single fare for a one-off journey through to return passes for the entire academic year, there are options for everyone's travel arrangements. You can book tickets at any time throughout the year, so it is simple to book an extra journey or arrange travel for a visiting friend.



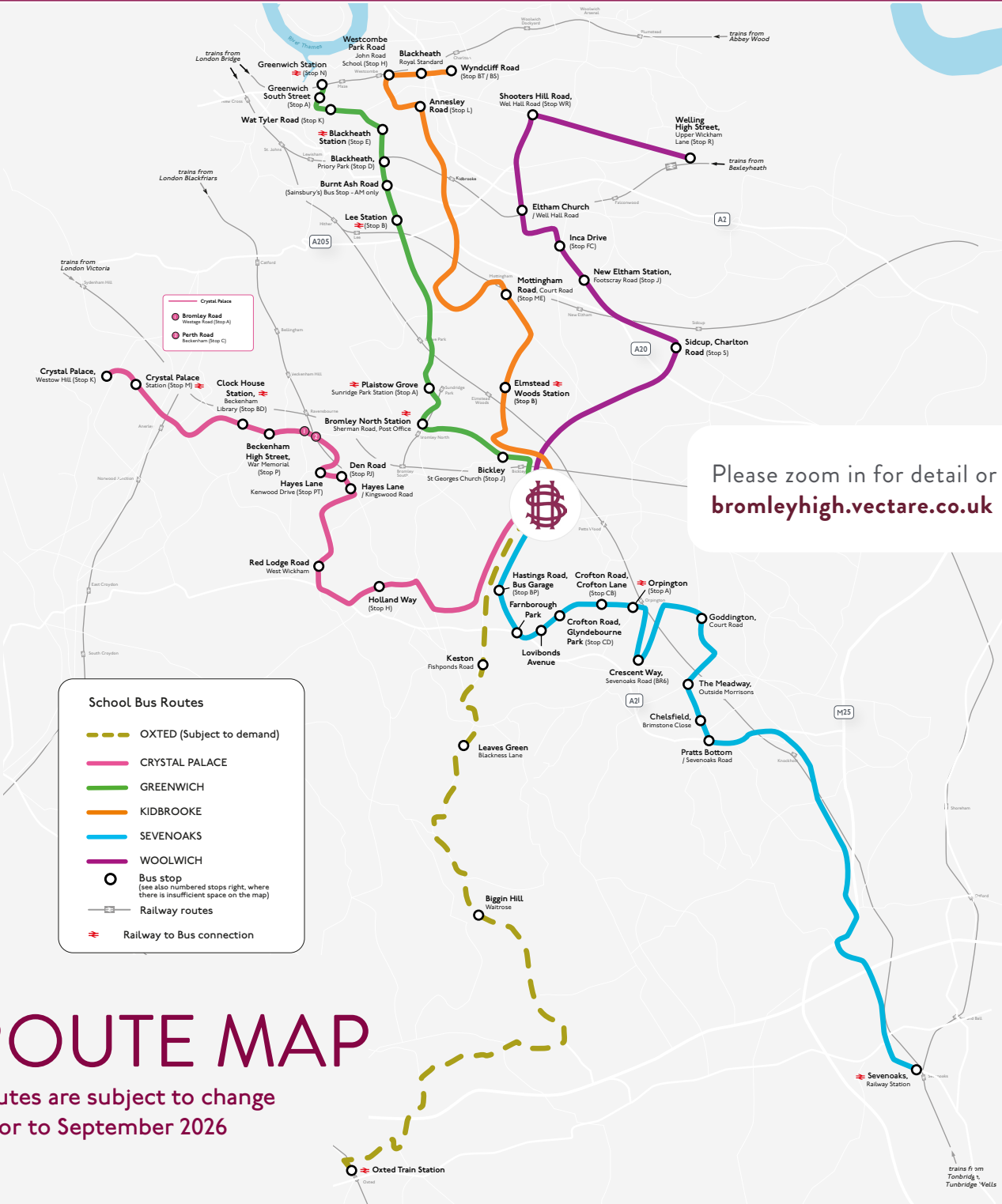

LATE BUS SERVICE

Late Bus

Departure from school: 17:30

Bromley High School will continue to provide a late bus service from September 2026. Buses will depart at approximately 17:30 servicing the areas north of the school.

Parents will need to book their daughter on the service at least 6 hours in advance through the online booking system and the exact route will be calculated each day depending on demand. You will receive a confirmation email upon booking the late bus service, which will confirm that your daughter is able to travel.

If you have any questions, or you need to change your booking, please get in touch with us via the Contact Us form online. Fares on the late bus service are the same as those on the other school bus services, and if you purchase a bus pass for the school bus service, your daughter can use the late bus service at no extra cost.

1 Go to bromleyhigh.vectare.co.uk to locate your nearest bus stop and book ad hoc or regular travel.

2 Make your booking and get instant confirmation.

OTHER TRANSPORT

Bikes

Girls are welcome to cycle to school, with bicycle racks situated just behind the science block at the rear of the site. It is recommended that bikes are secured using a suitable lock.

Cars

Girls may drive to and from school once written permission has been received from both their parents and Mrs Bird (Head of Sixth Form). Driving is only permitted once girls have obtained a full driving licence. Girls are not permitted to drive or park on the Bromley High School site; they should park considerably without causing inconvenience to local residents. Further details are available in the Sixth Form Drivers Policy, copies of which are available from Mrs Bird.

Please note: Bookings for next year must be made by 17th July, but are on a first-come, first served basis.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. This agreement is made between all school bus passengers, their parents and Bromley High School in order to provide safe, comfortable and civilised journeys for all passengers.
2. Arrangements for pupils' journeys to and from school are the responsibility of their parents. To assist with discharging this responsibility, Bromley High School provides a School Bus Service.
3. Transport on the School Bus Service must be arranged in advance and is paid for through the Vectare booking system. If you wish for your child to use the School Bus Service on an ad-hoc basis, or to vary the details of their bus travel as a one-off, you should book travel via the online website prior to travel. A charge of £15.57 per single journey is levied for individual trips depending on location.
4. Bookings on the School Bus Service are non-refundable in the event of a pupil failing to travel. Regular travel must be booked for a full academic year.
5. Bookings are to be made online via bromleyhigh.vectare.co.uk.
6. Each pupil for whom an online form has been submitted will be added to a bus list detailing the service they travel on, their bus stop and what travel has been paid for. Their name will appear on a list, which will be checked by the driver.
7. It will be the parent's responsibility to inform the School via the Contact Us form on the website if they no longer wish for their child to use the School Bus Service. One full term's notice must be given by a parent prior to the removal of a pupil from the School Bus Service (apart from an ad-hoc journey).
8. No pupil is permitted to travel on the School Bus Service if not pre-booked for that bus, as they will not be insured to travel. Other arrangements for journeys to and from school must be made by them or their parents.
9. Pupils must travel to and from Bromley High School in full school uniform or a full school tracksuit (except on approved non-uniform days).
10. Pupils should be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled time of departure to ensure they don't miss the service.
11. Good conduct is required at all times. Bullying, shouting, use of foul language, dropping litter, playing music, or any other misbehaviour is strictly forbidden.
12. Except when embarking or disembarking, all passengers must remain seated with their seatbelts fastened correctly.
13. Whilst on a School Bus, all passengers must accept without question the authority of a member of Bromley High School staff, a transport company official, or a school prefect or bus monitor, who may ask them to obey any reasonable instruction such as to pick up litter, desist from certain actions or to move to a different seat.
14. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent withdrawal of permission to use the School Bus Service.
15. Bromley High School aims for 95% of journeys to operate within the transport industry window of tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late, however timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time.
16. Bromley High School reserves the right to increase the charges for the School Bus Service with effect from the commencement of each term, to reflect any increases in the cost of providing the School Bus Service. Bromley High School will give not less than one month's prior notice in writing of any increase. Where payment has already been made for the full academic year, payment of any outstanding amount resulting from an increase must be paid through the ParentPay account. In the event of any increase to the charges, parents will be entitled to remove the pupil from the School Bus Service prior to the commencement of the term in which the increase is to take effect and receive a refund of any funds already paid for the remaining portion of the academic year, without needing to give a full term's notice. Bromley High School will make every effort to mitigate the need for any increases to the charges during an academic year and will only do so where necessary.
17. Bromley High School reserves the right to amend the bus routes to meet pupil demand throughout the year.





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
